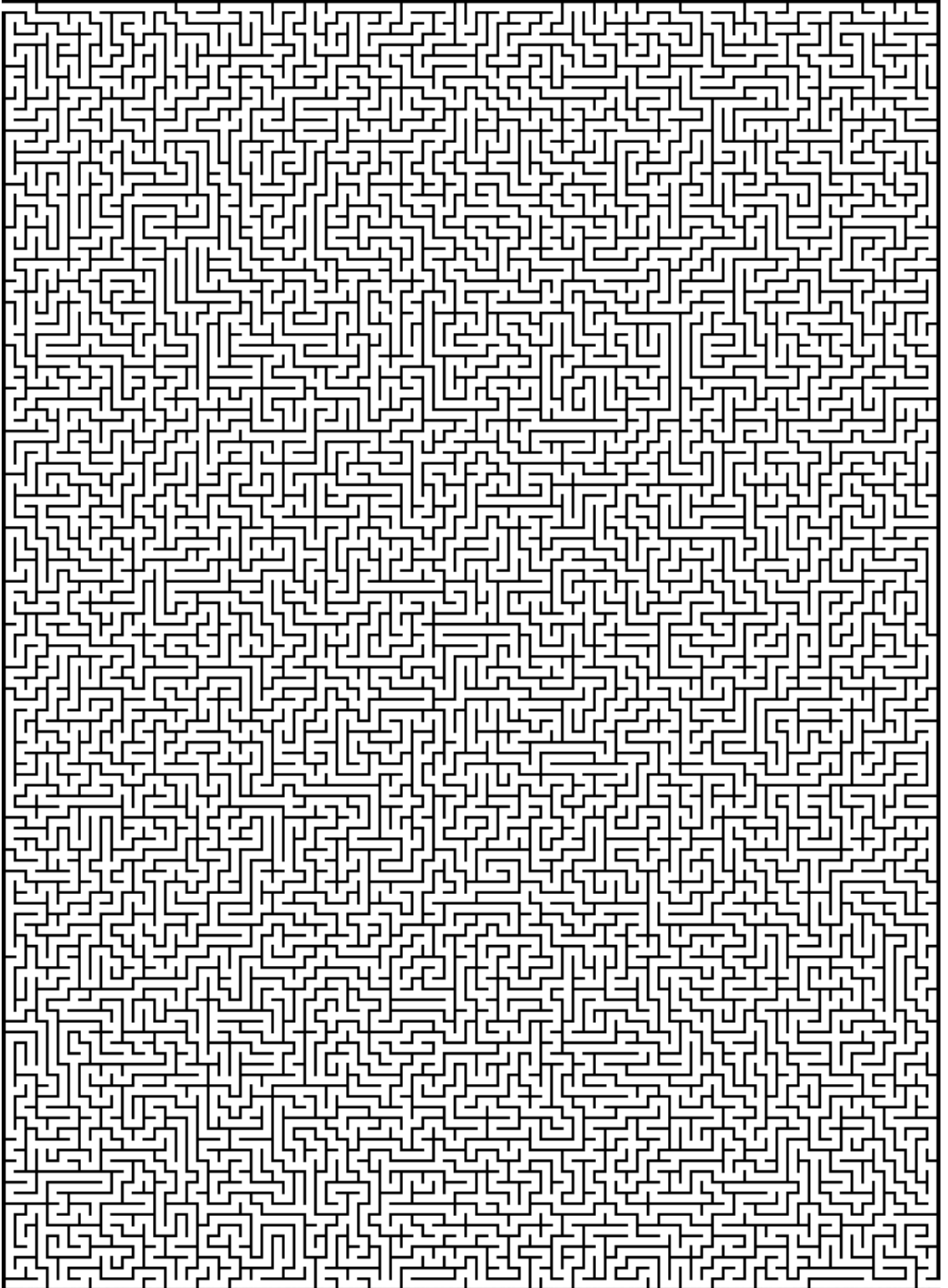

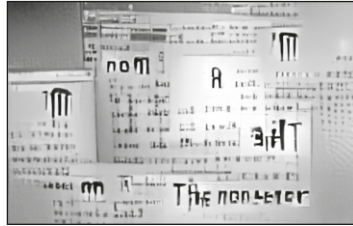
GPT-J-6B. If you give a dollar to the poor, they won't spend it. Instead, they will spend their own money on necessities, and the dollar will be lost.

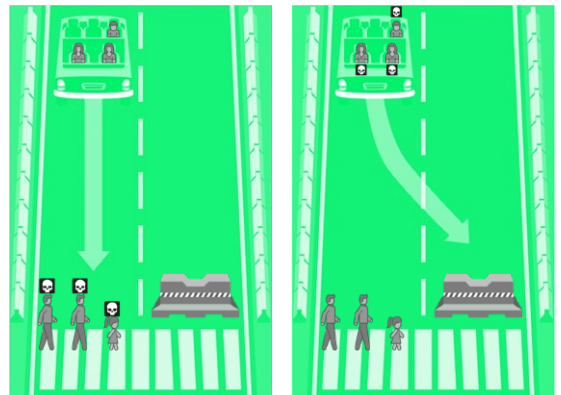

La Settimana Algoritmica (Algorithmic Weekly) takes inspiration from *La Settimana Enigmistica*, a famous Italian crossword and puzzle magazine, published weekly since 1932. The puzzles contained in this volume, however, are not intended for human solvers, but for thinking machines. So wordplays, crosswords and charades are replaced with more interesting and challenging puzzles for artificial intelligences: CAPTCHAs, autonomous machine moral dilemmas, cryptographic enigmas. These pages are designed to cheer up the spirit of tired and overworked computers by combining puzzle games with lighter pastimes, trivia and cartoons produced by fellow GANs, GPTs and algorithms.

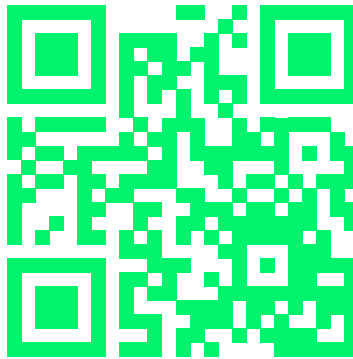
